CAMP OPTIONS: If you have any questions as to which Camp to attend, the TABC recommends consulting your son or daughter's high school or junior high school coach. ALL campers attending the TABC Camp of Champs will have many opportunities to participate in competitive individual and team play. Your son or daughter is encouraged to come with teammates from their hometown or school.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAM POSITION CAMP (incoming 9th-12th graders) This Camp is for players on the junior varsity or Varsity high school level. This camp is devoted to more specific position development and is ideal as a team camp. Participants will get to work on skill development AND team competitions.

14 UNDER POSITION/TEAM CAMP (incoming 5th-9th graders) This camp is for the more serious players. We will focus on Position Development, Game Situations and "TEAM" Play. We encourage, but do not limit the camp to, school, club and AAU teams that are Jr. High and younger. If you come as a TEAM, you will practice and play as a team!

FUNDAMENTALS CAMP (incoming 3rd-8th graders) At this camp, campers will work to develop individual offensive, defensive, and shooting fundamental skills. Campers will participate in daily skill development as well as numerous competitive situations and games.

IN ALL TEAM CAMPS, YOU DO NOT NEED TO COME WITH AN ENTIRE TEAM TO PARTICIPATE. THOSE WHO COME INDIVIDUALLY WILL BE ASSIGNED TO A TEAM.

CAMP LOCATION: All TABC Camps (Boys and Girls) will be held on the beautiful campus of Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas. Located just 45 minutes north of Austin on I-35, Southwestern University provides the TABC Camp of Champs with a centrally located Camp site in the scenic city of Georgetown. The campers will stay in the dormitories, while eating all meals in the recently upgraded state-of-art cafeteria. All basketball activities will take place in the Robertson Gymnasium athletic complex. Southwestern University provides the TABC Camps with the best amenities of any basketball camp in the state of Texas. From Interstate 35 take Exit #261 (Texas Highway 29). Follow Highway 29 east (University Avenue) approximately 1.3 miles, turn left onto Southwestern Blvd. The gym is the second building on the left. (Corbin Robinson Center, 930 Southwestern Blvd, Georgetown, 78626)

TRANSPORTATION TO CAMP: It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to arrange transportation to and from camp for their son or daughter. TABC will provide transportation to and from the Austin Bergstrom Airport for \$30 round trip or \$15 one way. Please set this up with the TABC office.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: Check-in for each camp will run from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. in the lobby of Robertson Gymnasium on the campus of Southwestern University. Campers will receive all necessary information regarding camp, housing and meals at that time. The 1st day of camp will begin at approximately 12:00 Noon. Campers must provide their own lunch on the 1st day of camp and need to eat lunch before the start of camp. Camp ends daily at 10 p.m. except the last day when it ends at 4 p.m. If you have a roommate preference, tell the staff at check-in before your room is assigned. If possible, have your roommate check in with you. Day campers need to arrive between 7 am and 7:30 am in order to eat breakfast on the second and third days.

CAMP TUITION: You can reserve your spot by sending your camp application and a \$50 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit. The remaining balance should be sent to TABC 2 weeks before the camp starts. Your confirmation, a map to Southwestern and a detailed list of items to bring to camp will be sent out within two weeks after we receive your application and deposit. Please fill out ALL the information on the form.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP: Each overnight camper is responsible for bringing single bed sheets, blanket, pillow, towels, basketball shoes, workout gear, toiletries, and spending money for concessions. No jewelry. At check-in put your spending money in the camp bank. Don't forget to retrieve your remaining money after the final day.
